### Okay... So what is a pediatric dentist and why does it matter?

Pediatric dentistry is the branch of dentistry that deals with the oral health of children from birth all the way through adolescence. Sometimes, a pediatric dentist may also cater to adults with special needs.

Pediatric dentists play a very important role in not only helping to maintain children's oral health, but also in educating parents on how to best assist their children.

#### 1. 4 years vs 6 years Advanced Education

Traditional dentist's receive four years of advanced schooling to prepare them for their dentistry careers. A pediatric dentist goes through the same four years of schooling as a traditional dentist, **plus an additional two years** of training to prepare them to specialize in infants, children, teens, and those with special needs. So when you take your child to a pediatric dentist, you can rest assured that they are in the hands of an extremely well trained professional.

#### 2. Child-Friendly Environment!

A pediatric dentist will cultivate a friendly environment for children! Many pediatric dentists will have themed rooms, special prizes, props, and rewards to help distract, comfort, and excite children about the dentist. These things create a welcoming, comfortable, and exciting environment for children. This is especially a benefit if your child tends to get nervous about doctors and dentist appointments.

#### 3. Familiar with Children Issues

Because pediatric dentists are specifically trained and specialize in dealing with children, they are far more familiar with childhood habits, common childhood dental issues, and oral health issues that pertain specifically to children. This makes these issues easier to spot for them than a traditional dentist who deals with patients of all ages.
